



Keys Areas to be addressed

 Forgiving road environment
- Developing a Road Safety Culture related to values, attitudes and the behavior of all road users, the community, decision makers & Government

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Effective Road Safety Programs & measures for Greece

- Road safety education and campaigns
- Traffic enforcement including speed controls, controls for seat belt, helmet and child restrain use, alcohol controls and mobile use controls.
- Road Safety Audit
- Speed management systems in the urban and the rural road network
- Identification of hazardous locations and implementation of countermeasures
- Improvement of post-crash care



Priority to Youth

- High mortality rates of young people (especially the ages 15 to 20)
- High rates of **delinquent behavior** in adolescence
- High school students: most vulnerable for drinking and driving
- Difficulty controlling emotions and managing stressors
- Less activation of several brain regions

 (frontal prefrontal cortex, parietal and cingulate)
- Ideal group for primer prevention and reducing involvement in traffic violations

Scouting for Global Road Safety Research on Road Safety Attitudes Among Youth

23rd World Scout Jamboree (28.07-08.08 2015) Japan

The main research objectives of the questionnaire were to track the perceptions and attitudes of **"underage drinking", "drinking and driving"** as well as issues concerning **traffic culture** in general. The results will lead to the development of intervention and prevention programs based on cross cultural issues and references to other countries

Pilot study for road safety attitudes and beliefs

Qualitative and quantitative research to academic standards (survey, case studies, questionnaires & interviews)
